Titus Project South Africa Begins Successfully...



A ministry of Youth With a Mission, **TITUS PROJECT** equips graduates of the School of Biblical Studies with teaching skills and sends them into areas of the world to pastors and leaders who can't afford or have access to Bible training.

## MINISTRY LAUNCH

After years of planning, Titus Project South Africa launched this month! This is **HISTORIC** because its the only Titus Project ever run on the continent of Africa. **I'm leading a school of 17 students from 10 nations!** (pictured above) We will be sending out teams to **4 AFRICAN NATIONS:** Botswana, Zambia, Swaziland, & Tanzania. As you read this, we will already be on the ground in these nations. I will be leading the

Tanzania team, reinvesting in a nation we began relationship with last year. I'll send an update from each team later this fall.

**LONG TERM FRUIT:** This is just the beginning! Titus Project will now be an established ministry on the African continent that trains and sends out Bible teachers. **9 of my current students are committed to return to work long term.** So I will have co-workers!

William & Paul, Sudanese refugee pastors recently graduated the School of Biblical Studies in Uganda! I first introduced them to you when I came back from Uganda 2 years ago.
